<p>Poetry Collect Poems for Children by Ted Hughes</p> <p>Children will be reading a wide range of poems in the anthology and answering questions linked to the VIPERS skills.</p> <p>Fiction text The Curse of the Maya by Johnny Pearce</p> <p>Children will study and read this text and answer VIPER skills questions. Retrieval and inference questions will take precedence in the lead up to SATS. This book will link with our Mayan art unit this term.</p>	<p>Poetry based on the book 'Moth' by Isobel Thomas</p> <p>The children will be sentence stacking an adaptation of this book into a poem. They will learn about how moths adapted over time to survive the Industrial Revolution. They will then research an animal of their choice that has adapted to survive and write a poem about it in the style of the book.</p> <p>Fiction Text: Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo</p> <p>Children will sentence stack part of the adventure story which the class teacher will model, they will then continue the plot points independently or adapt the story / characters with their own innovations.
